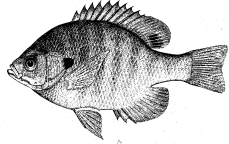
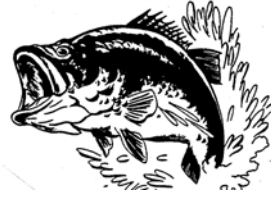

Who Can Go To Fish Camp?

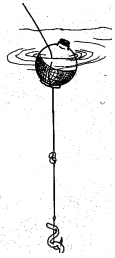
