For 4-H members to receive recognition for *Standards of Excellence*, they must complete all of the performance standards listed for their age.

Project Achievement (Ages 8-11)

Standards to Achieve:

1. Establish Plans for member's project and make report on project to leader. Independent members must present complete Project Plan to Unit staff.
2. Attend at least 2/3 of club meetings (or number established by club). Independent members must meet with mentor a minimum of four times during the program year.
3. Share project experiences by giving a presentation or making an exhibit.

Service Achievement (Ages 12-14)

Standards to Achieve:

1. Establish Plans for member's project and make report on project to leader. Independent members must present complete Project Plan to Unit staff.
2. Attend at least 2/3 of club meetings (or number established by club). Independent members must meet with mentor a minimum of four times during the program year.
3. Share project experiences by giving a presentation or making an exhibit.
4. Serve on committee or hold an office.
5. Take part in a community service activity related to member's project.
6. Assist group leaders with a special activity, tour or program.

Leadership Achievement (Ages 15-18)

Standards to Achieve:

1. Establish Plans for member's project and make report on project to leader. Independent members must present complete Project Plan to Unit staff.
2. Attend at least 2/3 of club meetings (or number established by club). Independent members must meet with mentor a minimum of four times during the program year.
3. Share project experiences by giving a presentation or making an exhibit.
4. Serve on committee or hold an office.
5. Take part in a community service activity related to member's project.
6. Assist group leaders with a special activity, tour or program.
7. Participate in one or more unit, regional or state level learning experience.
8. Provide leadership for project, an activity or for a group.
9. Assist in conducting programs at the county level or beyond.
