Clothing and Textiles Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the Clothing and Textiles Division, 4-H members must be enrolled in: **Sewing and Textiles I – *Under Construction* Pub. BU-08060 OR Sewing and Textiles II – *Fashion Forward* Pub. BU-08061 OR Sewing and Textiles III – *Refine Decision* Pub. BU-08062 Clothing Decisions I- *Discovering Choice* Pub. BU-7360 OR Clothing Decisions II- *Managing Choice* Pub. BU-7361**
2. See General Projects Guidelines
3. All items will be displayed at the fairgrounds throughout the fair. Items should be covered with clear plastic and on hangers when appropriate.
4. Clothing garments from Sewing and Textiles I, II, and III are eligible for consideration for the Clothing Revue at the State Fair provided the 4-H member meets minimum age requirements.
5. Every attempt will be made to offer modeling instruction prior to the clothing revue.
6. For classes 02, 03, 05, 06, and 07 listed below, subclasses will be as follows:
SubClass A- Construction (overall construction quality of item)
SubClass B- Fit and Appearance (overall fit and appearance of item)
7. County may submit construction entries for State Fair. Additional entries may be submitted in Fashion Review.

Class 01- Sewing and Textiles I – Non Clothing Constructed Article

Exhibit a pillow, 9-patch or square, or a tote/shopping bag. 4-H members may use their own pattern or instructions and patterns are available in the Extension office. Include the pattern at time of judging.

Class 02- Sewing and Textiles I – Constructed Garment

Exhibit a simple article of clothing. Patterns must be included at time of judging.

Class 03- Sewing and Textiles II- Non Clothing Constructed Article

Exhibit any non-wearable item made by the member. Include the pattern at time of judging.

Class 04- Sewing and Textiles II- Constructed Garment

Exhibit any garment with facings or curves. Include the pattern at time of judging.

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Class 05- Sewing and Textiles III- Constructed Garment

Exhibit a garment appropriate for the age and experience of the member. (Possible examples are: wool garment, polar fleece garment, dress or jacket with set in sleeves and zipper or buttons and button holes, suits, evening wear, or sport outfit.)

Class 06- Sewing and Textiles III- Restyled Garment

Exhibit a modified/redesigned/recycled garment that you purchased in the past and "salvaged."

Class 07- Sewing and Textiles- Fashion Revue

Participants will model constructed garments or purchased garments and will be evaluated on stage presence and overall look. Pillows and other non-garment items are not appropriate for Fashion Revue. 4-H members must choose either constructed garment or purchased garment, but may not model both.

Class 08- Clothing Decisions I

Exhibit a display of one completed activity from the project book. Inclusion of an actual purchased item is optional. Project book must accompany project.

Class 09- Clothing Decisions II

Exhibit a display of one completed activity from the project book. Inclusion of an actual purchased item is optional. Project book must accompany project.
