Performing Arts Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the Performing Arts Division, the 4-H member or group must be enrolled in: **Theatre Arts I – *Playing the Role*, Pub. BU-08070 OR
Theatre Arts II- *Become a Puppeteer!*, Pub. BU-08071 OR
Theatre Arts III- *Set the Stage*, Pub. BU-08072**
2. See General Projects Guidelines.
3. Individual items must be labeled with the member's name.
4. A copy of the scene or entire story or play must also be included when appropriate.
5. Class 01, 02, and 03 will be divided by the following subclasses:
SubClass A- Individual
SubClass B- Group

Class 01-Playing the Role

Exhibit a portfolio of activities completed during the current year **OR** a display illustrating a drawing/photograph of a clown character created by the exhibitor **OR** a display illustrating a picture story developed by the exhibitor.

Class 02-Become a Puppeteer

Exhibit a portfolio of activities completed during the current year **OR** a display on the history of puppets or puppetry in different cultures **OR** display a puppet created by the exhibitor **OR** display a story wheel and play adapted or written for puppets.

Class 03- Set the Stage

Exhibit a portfolio of activities completed during the current year **OR** a display that includes a sound, props, and costume charts appropriate for a selected scene for a story or play (limited to no more than 8 items) **OR** a scene design model to depict a scene from a script **OR** a display illustrating a character with make-up drawn or colored in. Include a photograph of a person wearing the make-up and information on the character's personality or part in the play.

Class 04- Theatre Arts Club Display

A club who has completed Theatre Arts as a group should prepare a display related to three activities they have completed in the project. Three or more club members must man the display at the time of judging. All members present should be able to discuss the project with the judge.
