

Edgar County Community Club Member Attendance/Participation Policy

In order to participate in the 4-H Fair exhibition:

1. A 4-H Community Club members must attend a minimum of five [5] meetings and each Community Club shall have a minimum of nine [9] meetings each program year. First year members joining on or before April 1st will be required to attend two [2] meetings.
2. Each 4-H Community Club member shall give a talk or a demonstration, either individual or with a partner(s).
3. Each 4-H Community Club member shall participate as part of their community club's responsibilities in at least two of the following activities each year:
 - Pork Chop BBQ Bash (BBQ Preparation)
 - Pork Chop BBQ
 - Fair Preparation (Individual or Club will work with Extension Staff to determine priorities)
 - Edgar County 4-H Association fundraising events

Edgar County Independent Study Member Attendance/Participation Policy

In order to participate in the 4-H Fair exhibition:

1. An Independent Study 4-H member must complete the Edgar County Independent Study Agreement at the time of enrollment.
2. Each Independent Study member shall have a minimum of six [6] contacts with a designated mentor. Mentor may be a club leader or an Extension Staff member. Contacts may be in person, through written correspondence, telephone conversations or e-mail and must be monthly, beginning no later than January of the program year. Contacts must include information on 4-H project work planned or accomplished.
3. Each 4-H Community Club member shall participate as part of their community club's responsibilities in at least two of the following activities each year:
 - Pork Chop BBQ Bash (BBQ Preparation)
 - Pork Chop BBQ
 - Fair Preparation (Individual or Club will work with Extension Staff to determine priorities)
 - Edgar County 4-H Association fundraising events
