

COLLECTIONS DIVISION

Collections Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in Collections, the 4-H member must be enrolled in Collections. This is a county project and is not eligible for state fair.
2. See General Projects Guidelines.
3. This project area is exempt from the 2-1/2' x 2-1/2' size limitation.
4. Exhibit a representative sample of your collection, not to exceed ten items, and submit a one-page report on how you became involved with collecting and describe some of your favorite pieces.
5. The same representative sample of a collection cannot be exhibited more than once.
6. The Extension Council, 4-H Association, staff or volunteers cannot be held responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen exhibits. It is therefore recommended that valuable objects be protected in a display case or left at home.
7. Collections exhibitors may remove individual items with special value from their exhibit after judging. If an entire collection is removed after judging, a photo of the collection, provided by the exhibitor, must be displayed with the remainder of the exhibit until all projects are released.
