

LLAMA DIVISION

Llama Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the llama division, the 4-H member must be enrolled in **Llamas**. This is a county project (no Llama Division at State Fair Junior level). County office has an approved Illinois 4-H Llama Publication.
2. See General Livestock Rules.
3. Ownership by June 1, Current Year
4. All Llamas must be the property of the exhibitor or by family partnerships. Proof of ownership must accompany the animal.
5. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per class.
6. Llamas should be presented for judging with a halter and lead. Halters shall not have tassels or removable decorations.
7. Nursing Llama mothers may not be accompanied in the show ring by their babies.
8. Unruly animals may be dismissed from the show ring by the judge or superintendent.
9. Youth ten years old and under are not eligible to show adult intact males. This is a safety factor.

Class 08- Yearling Male - 13 to 24 months

Class 09- Two Year Old Male - 25 to 36 months
