

RABBIT DIVISION

Rabbit Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the rabbit division, the 4-H member must be enrolled in:
Rabbit I - *What's Hoppening?* Pub. BU-6069 OR
Rabbit II - *A Jump Ahead* Pub. BU-6070 OR
Rabbit III - *Leaps and Bound* Pub. BU-6071
2. See General Livestock Rules.
3. Ownership by June 1, current year.
4. Rabbits shown in the Rabbit Show may not be shown in the Small Pets Show rabbit as a pet class.
5. Pen assignments will be made by the Rabbit Superintendent.
6. It is permissible to bring small accessories to cool animals such as portable fans or icepacks. These are the responsibility of the 4-H member.
7. No does with babies six weeks old or younger may be entered.

RABBIT SHOW

MARKET SHOW Rules:

1. Entrants are limited to 2 entries in the fryer class and 1 entry in the meat pen.
2. Meat pen is comprised of 3 rabbits--2 fryers and 1 other fryer.
3. Rabbits shown in Market Show may not be in Breeding Show.
4. Rabbits exhibited in fryer class MUST be 70 days of age or less and must weigh between 3 and 5 pounds on day of show.
5. 4-H Member may elect to sell one fryer in the 4-H Livestock Auction.

Class 01 - Individual Fryer - either sex

Class 02 - Meat Pen Trio

BREEDING SHOW Rules:

1. Entrants are limited to 2 entries per subclass with no more than 8 total entries in Breeding Show.
2. Breeding Show entries are not eligible to sell in 4-H Livestock Auction.
3. The following subclasses will be used in classes 03-06:

Subclass A- Buck

Subclass B- Doe

Class 03 - Pre-Junior Rabbit - Under 3 months of age

Class 07 - Junior Showmanship - Ages 8 to 13 years.

Class 08 - Senior Showmanship - Ages 14 to 18 years.

Class 09 - Rabbit Animal Science Display - Suggested topics could include-Types of rabbit feed, Grooming products and procedure, Rules or laws for raising rabbits, Design rabbit housing
