

## SWINE DIVISION

### Swine Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the swine division, the 4-H member must be enrolled in :  
**Swine I - *Squeal Appeal* Pub. BU-6158 OR**  
**Swine II - *Hamming it Up* Pub. BU-6159 OR**  
**Swine III - *Going Whole Hog* Pub. BU-6160 OR**
2. Refer to General Livestock Rules.
3. Ownership of all hogs by June 1, current year.
4. Entrants limited to showing the number of hogs specified in each show.
5. All Registration and Health Papers are due to Superintendents by 7:00 pm Sunday. They will be available for pick up on Wednesday in the office.
6. Show order will be posted in the barn by 3pm on Monday. Show **may not** be in class number order.

### MARKET SWINE

#### Rules and Regulations

1. All market hogs will be weighed and numbered during posted hours on Sunday. At weigh-in, 4-H members must indicate market swine they wish to sell at the Livestock Auction, if any.
2. Superintendents will determine Class divisions for hogs based on this weight.
3. Class divisions may include light-weight, medium-weight , and heavy-weight.
4. Heavy-weights show first; medium-weights second; light-weights last.
5. Only Market hogs may be sold in livestock auction.
6. Each exhibitor will be limited to two animals in the Market Swine show.
7. Market Swine must be farrowed on or after January 15, current year.
8. Market Swine may **NOT** be shown in the Breeding Swine Show.

Class 03 - Pair of Market Hogs TWO animals either two barrows, two gilts, or one barrow and one gilt.

## SWINE DIVISION (CONT.)

### BREEDING SWINE

#### Rules and Regulations

1. Superintendents will verify registration papers for all Purebred Breeding Swine.
2. Purebred Swine will be shown by age. Commercial Gilts will be shown in one class regardless of age.
3. Breeding Swine are not permitted to be sold in Livestock Auction.
4. Entrants will be limited to showing two boars and four gilts, with no more than two per class per subclass.
5. Hogs shown in Breeding Swine Division may **NOT** be shown in Market Swine Division.
6. The following subclasses will apply to classes 04-08:

**SubClass A - Berkshire**

**SubClass C - Duroc**

**SubClass E - Hereford**

**SubClass G - Poland China**

**SubClass I - Yorkshire**

**SubClass B - Chester White**

**SubClass D - Hampshire**

**SubClass F - Land Race**

**SubClass H - Spotted Poland China**

#### Class 04 - Purebred Gilt January 1 - February 15

#### Class 05 - Purebred Gilt February 16 - March 15

Class 06 - Purebred Breeding Herd - Three gilts of the same breed, that have been exhibited in purebred classes above.

Class 07 - Commercial Gilt - no age division.

Class 08 - Commercial Pair - two gilts.

**SHOWMANSHIP** Member must be enrolled in Swine and show their own animal to participate in Showmanship class. Exhibitor age is 4-H age as of September 1 of previous year. **4-H members must enter the showmanship class on their individual fair registration forms to show. No late entries allowed.**

Class 09- Junior Showmanship - Ages 8 - 10 years

Class 10 - Intermediate Showmanship - Ages 11 - 13 years

Class 11 - Senior Showmanship - Ages 14 - 18 years
