

## 4-H POULTRY SHOW

(Poultry is NOT included in the 5 only livestock entries.)

1. Comply with 2009 Illinois Department of Agriculture Exhibition Livestock Health Requirements.
2. Please do not bring animals that are obviously sick. You will be asked to remove them from the fairgrounds immediately.
3. Each exhibitor shall be limited to one entry per class and to one breed.
4. Cockerels and pullets must be hatched after Jan. 1 of current year; roosters and hens must have been hatched prior to Jan. 1 of current year.
5. A trio is composed of three fowl of the same breed, two pullets and one cockerel or two hens and one rooster.
6. Check in time is Wednesday, June 24, 8:00 a.m. in the rabbit/poultry tent. Judging will be at 9:00 a.m.; exhibitor must be present for judging.
7. Poultry will be released at 6:00 p.m. the same day.
