

CLOTHING & TEXTILES – (See Jr. Fair Department M-1) – JUDGING SCHEDULE - Saturday, July 25

Judging and Fashion Revue (style show) will be held during the General Projects judging.

SPECIAL NOTE: Knitting has been moved from Clothing & Textiles to Visual Arts/Fiber (Original) or Visual Arts/Heritage Arts (Pattern). The exhibitor must be present during judging. The Fashion Revue will be held at 8:00 a.m. During the style show, the garment will be judged on fit and appearance. Then you will be able to bring the clothing item on hanger to be judged for construction. Purchased and constructed garments will be evaluated on the member, in addition to the conference with the judge. Construction and appearance will both be considered. While on display, garments should be covered in a clear plastic bag (no garment bags). Exhibit tags should be attached to GARMENT, not to the hanger. **SPECIAL NOTE: Knitted exhibits fall under Visual Arts, however, knitted garments may still be considered for Fashion Revue.**

If a pattern was used to make the garment, pattern instructions to be included with the exhibit. Garment/items will not be placed on display unless covered in a clear plastic bag (no garment bags). Construction and appearance will both be considered. Exhibit tags should be attached to GARMENT, not to the hanger.

Choose one of the items listed in the project you are enrolled in to exhibit.

* **Sewing & Textiles I (sew/serge)** – One tote bag using directions provided by Extension Office –or- shopping bag –or- constructed 9 Patch Pillow –or- square pillow –or- Constructed garment - A simple article of clothing.

* **Sewing & Textiles II (sew/serge)** – Non clothing – Any non-wearable item made by member –or- Constructed garment – Any garment with facings or curves

* **Sewing & Textiles III (sew/serge)** – Construction – Garment constructed by member, which is appropriate for age and experience of member. (Possible examples: wool garment, polar fleece garment, dress or jacket with set in sleeves and zipper or buttons and button holes, suits, evening wear or sport outfit) –or- Restyled Garment – A modified/redesigned/recycled garment you purchased in the past and “salvaged” by significantly altering the original design. A 3” X 5” minimum size photo of the original garment (before recycling) should be included.

* **Clothing Decisions I**– Exhibit a display of one completed activity from the project book. Inclusion of an actual purchased item is optional.

* **Clothing Decisions II** – Exhibit a display of one completed activity from the project book. Inclusion of an actual purchased item is optional.

* **CLOVER CHALLENGE: Clothing & Textiles** – Exhibit a display illustrating the Clover Challenge area explored. See General Rule #17 regarding Clover Challenge requirements. **The completed Illinois 4-H Clover Challenge Agreement must be presented with the exhibit.**
