

DEPARTMENT M01: VISUAL ARTS

Rules:

1. All general rules (pages 6-11 & 57) apply.
2. Exhibits must be produced in the current year.
3. All items must be properly prepared for exhibit. Items which are intended to be hung, must be prepared for hanging. The hanging device must be sturdy enough to support the weight of the object. Firmly attach exhibit tag to the upper left-hand corner of the exhibit.
4. It is suggested that drawings and paintings should be matted and/or framed, preferably under glass. By putting these articles under a protective covering you will not have to worry that they will become soiled. Framing and /or matting can improve the overall appearance of the article. There is no specific type of requirement for type of matting. Purchased and precut mats are acceptable.
5. Exhibitors are asked to register according to the Junior and Senior age divisions listed below.
6. Superintendents reserve the right to combine or eliminate classes that are lacking in number of entries.

SECTION M10—Jr. Division for youth age 8-13 as of Sept 1, 2008

CLASSES

M0100 Paper

Any item made of paper. Scrapbooks acceptable.

M0101 Fiber

Any item made of fiber. Original knitted or crocheted items belong here.

M0102 Clay

Any item made of clay. May be fired or unfired, hand formed or thrown on a wheel. Self-hardening clays, fire/oven-cured and cornstarch clay are acceptable.

M0103 Wood

Any art item made of wood (carving, sculpture, collage, wood burning, etc.) Utilitarian wood items (e.g. outdoor or indoor furniture or shelves) should not be in visual arts.

M0104 Chalk/Crayon/Marker

Any artwork done with colored pencils, chalk, charcoal, crayons or markers on paper or canvas. This would include sketching, drawing, cartooning, printing, etc.

M0105 Pen/Ink /Pencil

Any artwork done with pencils, pen or ink on paper or canvas. This would include sketching, drawing, cartooning, printing, etc.

M0106 Painting

Any artwork that is done with any type of paint or dye on paper or canvas.

M0107 Glass/ Plastic

Any item made of glass or plastic. Stepping stones and wall hangings should be placed here. INTERLOCKING CREATIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED (i.e. Connects or Legos).

M0108 Metal

Any item made of metal. Items intended for industrial use are not considered part of visual arts.

M0109 Nature

Any item made of natural material, such as wreaths, cornhusk dolls, etc. Candles are not suitable as entries. Items should be made of NATURAL material (which may be purchased) but securing elements such as glue and wire may be used in the interconstruction as long as they do not detract from the overall "natural" appearance. Items may be displayed under glass for protection. Baskets should be entered in Heritage Arts.

M0111 Three Dimensional Design/Mixed Media

Art pieces in this class must be comprised of at least three different media. No one medium can make up more than 40% of a piece. The piece should be free-standing (not meant to be hung) that is observable on at least three different sides. Originality and design are important concepts.

- M0112 Computer Generated Art
Any artwork that was created on the computer using pixels and any software package. Exhibit may not include scanned work, clip art, downloaded images, imported image, or photographs.
- M0113 Heritage Arts
A traditional art learned from another person or from a pattern may be entered in this class. Enter baskets and any crocheted or knitted items that use a pattern here.

SECTION M20—Sr. Division
for youth age 14 – 18 as of Sept. 1, 2008.

- M0200 Paper
Any item made of paper. Scrapbooks acceptable.
- M0201 Fiber
Any item made of fiber. Knitting or crocheting items belong in Heritage Arts class.
- M0202 Clay
Any item made of clay. May be fired or unfired, hand formed or thrown on a wheel. Self-hardening clays, fire/oven-cured and cornstarch clay are acceptable.
- M0203 Wood
Any art item made of wood (carving, sculpture, collage, wood burning, etc.) Utilitarian wood items (e.g. outdoor or indoor furniture or shelves) should not be in visual arts.
- M0204 Chalk/Crayon/Marker
Any artwork done with colored pencils, chalk, charcoal, crayons or markers on paper or canvas. This would include sketching, drawing, cartooning, printing, etc.
- M0205 Pen/Ink /Pencil
Any artwork done with pencils, pen or ink on paper or canvas. This would include sketching, drawing, cartooning, printing, etc.
- M0206 Painting
Any artwork that is done with any type of paint or dye on paper or canvas.
- M0207 Glass/ Plastic
Any item made of glass or plastic. Stepping stones should be placed here. INTERLOCKING CREATIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED (i.e. Connects or Legos).
- M0208 Metal
Any item made of metal. Items intended for industrial use are not considered part of visual arts.
- M0209 Nature
Any item made of natural material, such as wreaths, cornhusk dolls, etc. Candles are not suitable as entries. Items should be made of NATURAL material (which may be purchased) but securing elements such as glue and wire may be used in the inter construction as long as they do not detract from the overall “natural” appearance. Items such as dried flowers maybe displayed under glass for protection. Baskets should be entered in Heritage Arts.
- M0211 Three Dimensional Design/Mixed Media
Art pieces in this class must be comprised of at least three different media. No one medium can make up more than 40% of a piece. The piece should be free-standing (not meant to be hung) that is observable on at least three different sides. Originality and design are important concepts.
- M0212 Computer Generated Art
Any artwork that was created on the computer using pixels and any software package. Exhibit may not include scanned work, clip art, downloaded images, imported image, or photographs.
- M0213 Heritage Arts
A traditional art learned from another person or from a pattern may be entered in this class. Enter baskets or crocheted or knitted items made from a pattern here.
