Dairy Production Awards

Rules:

- A. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries in this class.
- B. Production awards based on DHI, or owner sampler, records will be presented in each breed to encourage the selection for high production and its relationship to good type and to illustrate the importance of milk production records.
- C. To qualify, production records (the most recent DHI 220 Monthly Report and, if available, the most recent DHI 103 Pedigree and Performance Evaluation) must be presented to dairy superintendent when animals are checked in on Wednesday, July 29.
- D. The animal must have a projected actual milk and be shown in its own breed class.
- E. Awards will be presented in each breed. In addition, a **supreme production award** and **reserve** will be awarded based on a comparison to breed averages.
