Gilt Show - Saturday, August 1 - 8 a.m.

Rules:

- A. ****NEW...** Ear notch identification of crossbred swine does not satisfy USDA identification requirements for brucellosis and pseudorabies testing. See page 20.
- B. Each exhibitor will be limited to four single barrows, two barrow pairs, four single gilts and two gilt pairs, of any breed or crossbred, including premiere barrows for a maximum of four barrows. Barrows must be farrowed on or after January 15, 2009. Gilts must be farrowed on or after January 1, 2009. Pair animals cannot be shown in a pair unless shown as a single.
- C. Weigh-in for barrows and crossbred gilts and registration papers will be checked for purebred gilts on Wednesday, July 29, noon–6 p.m. All barrows and crossbred gilts will be divided into weight classes, and purebred gilts will be divided into age classes, to a maximum of 10 entries. Divisions will be determined after all swine are checked in.
- D. Gilts cannot be shown in the market barrow classes.
- E. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animals.
- F. Superintendents will announce time of weighing. Each member will be responsible for weighing his/her swine.
- G. All swine **must be ear notched** with a completely healed ear. Ear tags are not accepted. Ear notches should be listed by veterinarian on CVI (health papers). Notches of purebred barrows and gilts must conform to the requirements of the breed associations. Ear notches will be required to be turned in on fair entry. Each exhibitor is limited to 20 barrows and 20 gilts for nomination.
- H. All animals must be owned by June 1, 2009. All purebred swine must have individual registration papers and must be presented to certify breed. All registration papers must bear the ear mark of the pig. These marks must be the same as those on the pig.
- I. All first place winners will show for breed champion.
- J. Breed champions will show for Grand Champion Purebred.
- K. Crossbred class winners will show for Crossbred Grand Champion.
- L. Reel's Sale Barn will be available to load 4-H pigs on August 2, at project release. Hogs will be tagged Sunday, August 2 at 8 a.m. Exhibitors may attend the sale at noon on August 3.
- M. Exhibits must conform to Exhibition Livestock Health Requirements.
- N. Some classes list more than one class number. Please make all entries in the **first class number listed**. Split classes will be posted before the show.

Premiere Swine Show

Judged Saturday, August 1, following gilt show
On-rail judged Thursday, August 6, at Bloomington Meats

Premiere barrows must be weighed on Wednesday, July 29.
Premiere barrows are eligible to enter in regular classes as well as premiere.

Rules:

1. Barrows must be born on or after February 10, 2009, and must be weighed by swine superintendents before they are 35 days of age, at which time they cannot weigh more than 1 pound per day of age.
2. Barrows must have a minimum hot carcass weight of 170 pounds, a maximum hot carcass weight of 225 pounds, a minimum carcass length of 30.5 inches, and a minimum 10th rib backfat of 0.5 inches.
3. Barrow ranking will be divided between carcass quality and rate of lean gain.
4. Each exhibitor will be limited to two entries.
5. Exhibitors are responsible for the disposal of their animal's carcass.
6. Any carcass that fails to meet the basic requirements for certification (10th rib fat maximum depth, loin eye area minimum square inches) will not be further evaluated.
7. An "on the foot" show will be held. Classes will be determined by weight with a maximum of 10 barrows per class. The on-rail portion of the show will be limited to 50 barrows.
8. Exhibitors may observe on-rail judging demonstration Thursday, August 6. Schedule will be posted. Exhibitors will be permitted in the cooler during judging at judge's discretion. Barrows will be slaughtered at Bloomington Meats.
