Junior High 4-H Camp

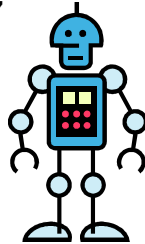
Camp is open to all youth ages 12 – 14, 4-H Membership is NOT required.

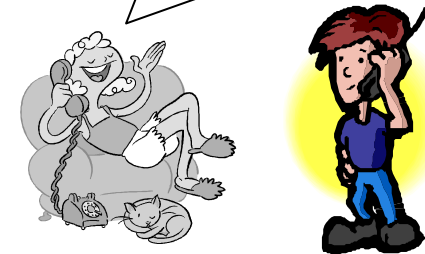

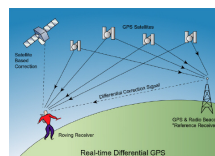
