## Animal Science Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the animal sciences division, the 4-H member must be enrolled in any level of the following project categories:

3. Refer to individual project category for suggested topics for displays.
4. Live animals are not permitted in the animal science displays.
5. County may submit **2** entries for state fair in any combination of all animal science displays including veterinary sciences. ALL display items should be affixed to the display board. No additional items should be included.

## Class 01-Animal Science Display

Prepare a display related to an activity completed in the project. Be prepared to discuss the activity and any results. For safety reasons, exhibits should NOT include syringes with needles. Exhibits may include activities from Veterinary Science projects or from any other Animal Science project area, including studies of animal physiology and/or animal behavior.
