Child Development Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the Child Development division, 4-H member must be enrolled in **Child Development II or Child Development III.**
2. See General Projects Guidelines
3. Each county may submit 2 entries for state fair.

Class 01 – Child Development I-

Exhibit one of the following options made by the member from the level I project book, Growing on my Own.

1. My learning box filled with things that help you learn and have fun. On a note card, paper, explain how you have used the box.
2. Prepare a choke-tube tester display labeled with toys that are “safe” and “unsafe.” On a note card or paper, explain why the toys are not safe for young children and how others can test toys for safety.

Class 02-Child Development II –

Include the following three items that would be appropriate for a child of a specific age. On a note card or page of paper, indicate the age of the child and how the item fits into the interests, abilities, and safety considerations of that child

1. A toy made by a 4-Her
2. A song or game
3. A story or story book that would be appropriate for a child of a specific age

Class 03-Child Development III –

Prepare a display of 6 toys and/or activities (at least one made by the 4-Her). Include two items for each of the following three age groups:

1. Infant/Toddler
2. Pre-School
3. School Age

Class 04-Child Development III –

Exhibit one or more of the following items developed by a member from the level III project book.

1. Child care career game
2. A display representing a community service activity
3. Teaching plan for use in a day care (2-4 hour time span)
- Or 4. Plan a neighborhood Olympics activity
