2. Each exhibitor should refer to the general livestock rules.
3. All cattle must meet the Illinois Livestock regulations on health.
4. Any animal that has dropped a calf will show in the cow class.
5. All first year exhibitors must have completed the QAEC training prior to June 15, 2009.
