Entomology Rules and Regulations:

1. In order to exhibit in the entomology division, the 4-H member must be enrolled in:

Entomology I, Entomology II, or Entomology III

2. See General Project Guidelines

3. This project area the size and number of cases should be relative to the number of insects displayed for a specified class. Cases should be no deeper than 4". Exhibitors should note that cases may be placed UPRIGHT for display.

4. County may submit one entry to State Fair.

Class 01 – Entomology I

Exhibit 15 or more species representing four or more orders. Collection must be accurately labeled. Exhibitors enrolled in the second or third year of the Entomology I project must also include an exhibit or display illustrating one of the completed activities in the Entomology I project manual, *Creepy Crawlies*. Members should be prepared to discuss skills learned.

Class 02 – Entomology II

Exhibit 30 or more species representing eight or more orders. Collection must be accurately labeled. Exhibitors enrolled in the second or third year of the Entomology II project must also include an exhibit or display illustrating one of the completed activities in the Entomology II project manual, *What's Bugging You*. Members should be prepared to discuss skills learned.

Class 03 – Entomology III

Exhibit 60 or more species representing twelve or more orders. Collection must be accurately labeled. Exhibitors enrolled in the second or third year of the Entomology III project must also include an exhibit or display illustrating one of the completed activities in the Entomology III project manual, *Dragons, Houses, and Other Flies*. Members should be prepared to discuss skills learned.

Class 04 – Entomology Display, Other

Exhibit an activity or display from the Entomology project books that does not fit into classes 01-03.
