Tractor Rules and Regulations

1. In order to exhibit in the Tractor division, the 4-H member must be enrolled in: **Tractor Acquaintance, Tractor Operation**
2. See General Projects Guidelines.
3. Counties may submit one entry for State Fair competition. State Tractor Driving Competitions may occur on a year-to-year basis. Contact the Extension office for more information.

Class 01- Acquaintance

Exhibit a display or poster that illustrates one of the following topics: tractor safety; care and maintenance; the tractor as a valuable farm machine; or an activity listed in the 4-H project manual.

Class 02 – Operation

Exhibit a display or poster that illustrates one of the following topics: cause and prevention of rollovers, diagram how an air cleaner works, diagram and identify an engine cooling system, regulations for battery and oil disposal, or another activity listed in the project manual.

Class 03 – Moving Out

Exhibit a display or poster that illustrates one of the following topics: wagon and bin hazards, diagram and identify open and closed hydraulic systems, mower types and safety features, conveyor types and safety features, or another activity listed in the 4-H project manual.

Class 04 – Learning More

Exhibit a display or poster that illustrates one of the following topics: method of winterizing a tractor, chemical uses and required safety equipment, parts and process of internal combustion engines, procedure for cleaning and flushing tractor radiator, or another activity.
